### **INDIAN POINT UNION TALKS MIGHT RESUME TUESDAY, ENTERGY MANAGEMENT JUST CAN'T PUT IT IN WRITING, TRYING TO PROVOKE A JOB ACTION**

Local 1-2 President James T. Slevin said Sunday, January 21 that Entergy called for a break in the marathon negotiations over the Indian Point contract to regroup and perhaps resume talks Tuesday, January 23. Slevin said, "Entergy has been circulating a memo which purports to be an offer from Management. It might well be, but it's not from the Management we have been talking to. When we asked that it be put into writing, they couldn't find a pen. The Union is ready to go. Management apparently needed some time, they're not used to a 'round the clock pace - we are. They ignore the fate of the working men and women who safely operate and maintain a nuclear power plant and they don't seem to care about the communities they are supposed to serve in New York State. Management seems more concerned with their sleep cycle than resolving the problems caused by its attacks on the welfare of Entergy's own employees. "
