



LOCAL 1-2 UPDATE

INDIAN POINT UNION TALKS SUSPENDED EARLY FRIDAY MORNING, ENERGY MANAGEMENT NEEDED BREAK FOR REST, TALKS RESUME LATER TODAY

Local 1-2 President James T. Slevin said early Friday morning that Entergy called for a break in the marathon negotiations over the Indian Point contract, so they could rest. Slevin said, “The Union was ready to go but management needed some beauty sleep, while its appointed “negotiators” and their overlords in Louisiana ignore the impact of their inaction on the fate of the working men and women who safely operate and maintain a nuclear power plant and on the communities they serve in New York State. I guess in Entergy’s case, it’s management is more concerned with its own comfort than resolving the problems it has caused by its attacks on the welfare of Entergy’s own employees. For our part, Local 1-2 is used to working round the clock and was prepared to do so tonight.” Slevin said he hoped and expected that talks would resume later today.
